Saddle Up with Dennis Brouse™ now airing on UNC-ED

Show about horses designed to appeal to horse enthusiasts & arm chair riders alike

May 28, 2009, Le Claire, Iowa – [Saddle Up with Dennis Brouse™](#), a public television series that celebrates the storied relationship between horse and human, is now airing on [UNC-ED](#).

The show, which is hosted by highly-respected horse trainer Dennis Brouse, airs on Saturday mornings at 8:30 a.m. and again in the afternoon at 1:30 p.m.

UNC-ED is part of UNC-TV, a 22-station network licensed to the University of North Carolina that provides statewide analog and digital television service.

“I am thrilled that Saddle Up with Dennis Brouse is now airing in North Carolina. The state’s horse industry is valued at more than \$500 million annually, and there are an estimated 225,000 horses in the state” said Brouse. “The series is more than a simple how-to show. In addition to training tips, it showcases the amazing relationship humans have with this magnificent animal.”

Saddle Up with [Dennis Brouse](#), which began airing on public television stations across the country in January of 2009, showcases a specific training question or situation addressed by Brouse with the horse’s owner. Special features will take viewers on a powerful journey into the horse world, highlighting everything from the mounted police, to barrel racing and hippotherapy, along with segments on special breeds and classes of horses.

Brouse has been working with horses since the age of 14. After spending time learning to train horses “the old fashioned way,” he quickly realized that he was at odds with this method. Since 1996, Dennis has spent thousands of hours studying and fine-tuning [his training methods](#). In 2002, he produced his first series of training tapes, and shortly thereafter produced a television show that aired on RFDTV.
