Season 2 is also filled with many historical segments that focus on the role horses played in these events, such as the life of Buffalo Bill Cody, Wyatt Earp, the Mormon Trail and Amish villages.

Brouse has been working with horses since the age of 14. After learning to train horses “the old fashioned way” using intimidation, he realized that he was at odds with this method and began developing his own safer, gentler techniques based on building a bond between human and horse. In 1996, Brouse started training horses on a full-time basis, and has since spent thousands of hours studying and fine-tuning [his training methods](#).
